During his residence at CUA School of Architecture and Planning, Trahan will also deliver a public lecture entitled "Peace Architecture: Designing for Healing and Connection" on Monday, Sept. 20th, at 5 p.m. EST.

"It is an honor to be chosen as the 2021 Walton Critic and contribute to such an important institution. This opportunity at CUA aligns two things that are vitally important to me—spiritual practices and design," said Trahan. "I'm looking forward to connecting with the students, faculty, and academic community at large to explore the practice of Peace Architecture."
